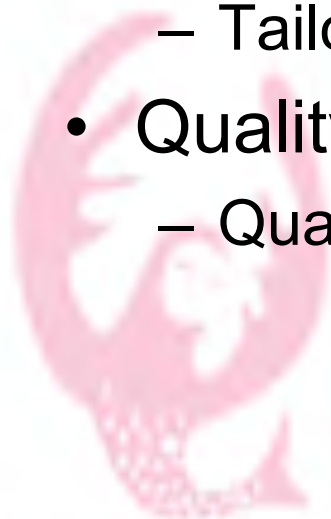
- Community based

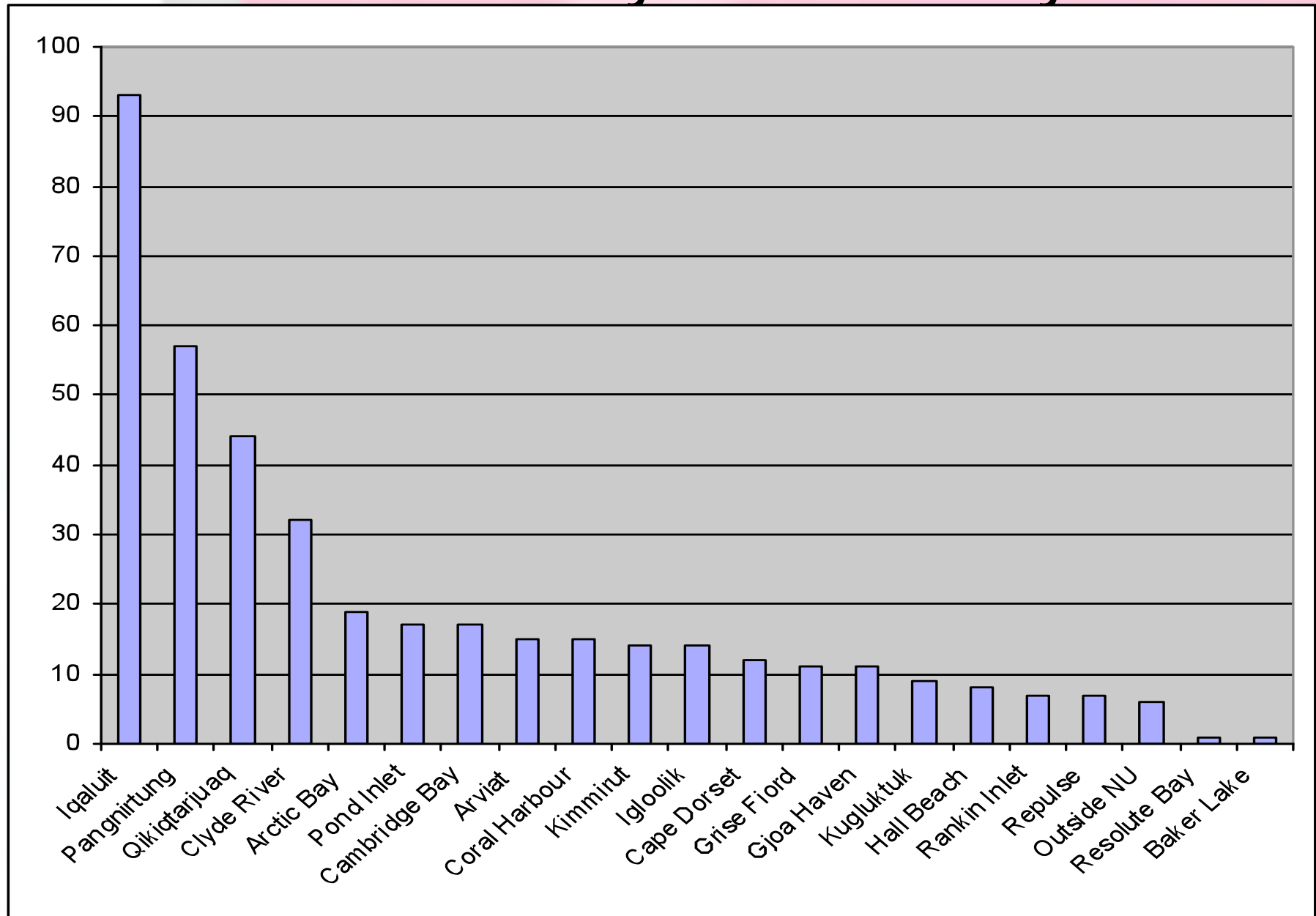
Inshore Training

- **Small Vessel Operator Proficiency**
 - Funded by Government of Nunavut
 - Includes ROC-M, Basic First-Aid and MED A-3
 - 103 students in 12 courses since September 2008
- **Netmaking**
 - Tailored to local fishing methods and species
- **Quality Control**
 - Quality management and hygiene for processors
